

In Dec. 2006, the Shared Governance Committee examined the assembly's resolutions from the past years. The resolutions that are assigned to the Technology's committee work over the past 12 years are listed below. The Technology committee responded to and updated their resolutions in Jan. 2007. The remarks are documented in the Follow-up Response column.

Technology	Title of Resolution	Follow-up Response
<u>2001-Sep-#09</u>	Express concern re decentralized information technology	Adopted 9/21/01; chair exchanged letters with President Broad.
<u>2003-Nov-#02</u>	Create centralized software licensing	Adopted 11/03. This resulted into a task force to study all the features of available Synchronous Learning Software Packages and to study currently used software packages on all UNC Campuses and to make recommendations to negotiate with the vendors for one or two packages for all campuses and provide the necessary support. The CENTRA software emerged as one of the packages and the collaborative had made arrangements for the free trial and training for all campuses.
<u>2005 - Nov. #05</u>	UNC System-wide Content Management System	Adopted 11/05. The task force to undertake the pilot has been formed and it is anticipated that the pilot would be launched in early 2007 and the report of the pilot would be presented at the last meeting of the assembly.
<u>2005-Feb-#05</u>	Resolution endorsing the continuation of the UNC TLT Collaborative	Adopted 2/05. UNC TLT Collaborative was renewed to continued.
